## **Road Closures During Construction**

June 5-9: Davis Street will be closed from Main Street (SR 65) to Howard street to allow a water main to be installed. Once it is installed, the road will be patched and opened back up to traffic from the railroad tracks east to Howard Street. Tom's Construction states that they will try to maintain the streets for the residents of Davis Street to their houses.

June 5-August 11th: South Street, Linden Street (from South Street to the Fire Station), Davis Street from Main Street (SR 65) east to the railroad tracks will be closed to all traffic. During this time, all of the sidewalks, curb, gutter and pavement will be torn out. The school is set for demolition at this time as well.

Parking for the Library will be in a marked area behind Subway.

## **VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER RECEIVES PRESTIGIOUS AWARDS**

The Village of Jackson Center has received two prestigious awards recently. First the Village was awarded the American Public Power Safety Award of Excellence for 2016. This is a great honor to all the Village employees that see the importance of safety and adhere to our Safety Training Programs. It takes 3 years of submitting information before a village can be considered for this award. Jackson Center proudly placed 1st in the less than 15,000 hour worked category.

In addition, the Jackson Center Municipal Electric System has been awarded RP3 (Reliable Public Power Provider) Platinum Level. This award is open to all 2003 public power providers in the nation. Thirteen providers from Ohio met the criteria for the award out of an eligible 219. Jackson Center received 91.5 points out of a possible 100. That put us in the Platinum division. The top level is Diamond and a score of 98 points is needed to achieve that level. I want to thank David Overman for all his help, dedication and enthusiasm during this process. It took considerable time to get our system, policies, procedures and safety practices up to the high standard needed to qualify for RP3. The Village will obtain this designation for 3 years and during this time will continue to improve all aspects of the system. Thanks to David Overman, Nathan Hensley and all of the Village employees for your dedication and commitment in achieving this award. Job well done!
