The Jackson Center Police Department would like to make all residents aware that the Village of Jackson Center is a member of the International Property Maintenance Code. These Codes were adopted into the Village of Jackson Center and put in place as Village Ordinances, therefore they are required by law and enforced to regulate that the maintenance of all properties, buildings and structures are well kept, safe, sanitary and fit for use.

What we are noticing is that the most common complaints filed are for violations against Exterior Property Sanitation; accumulation of rubbish or garbage, Motor Vehicles parked on the property and over grown grass, weeds and foliage.

The most recent Maintenance Code adoption is for the prohibiting against the spreading and dumping of grass clippings or yard waste; primarily the grass clippings being blown onto or left on the streets. Not only are the grass clippings left on the streets unsightly, but it also causes damage to the storm drains and sewer systems and creates a hazard for motorists. The Village has gone as far as giving its residents a location to dispose of their yard waste located on Jerry Drive, and everyone needs to take the opportunity to utilize this convenient resource. The Jackson Center Police Department will be taking a more aggressive approach on all unlawful violations of these ordinances and making contact with the property owners/tenants. If properties are not kept in compliance, we will be issuing citations and fines for said violations.
