



ORDINANCE 2020-030

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS IN THE 2020 ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Annual Appropriations for the year 2020, certain expenditures have differed from the anticipated expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1.

That the following adjustment be made in the Annual Appropriations Ordinance 2019-029:

That within the **Coronavirus Relief Fund**, appropriations be increased in the amount of **\$16,731.19** in appropriation account code 2151-790-400-0000 – Other Supplies and Materials. The purpose of this increase is to have appropriations available to purchase needed supplies using CARES Act monies. The revised appropriation budget for this appropriation account code is \$55,731.19, and the revised appropriation budget for all funds is \$10,040,447.14.


That within the **Coronavirus Relief Fund**, appropriations be established in the amount of **\$57,060.34** in appropriation account code 2151-790-600-0000 – Payment to Another Political Subdivision. The purpose of this increase is to be able to send the unused CARES Act monies back to the Shelby County Auditor. The revised appropriation budget for this fund is \$112,791.53 and the revised appropriation budget for all funds is \$10,097,507.48.

That within the **Mayor’s Court Fund**, appropriations be decreased in the amount of **\$1,667** in appropriation account code 9901-882-600-0000 – Payment to Another Political Subdivision. The purpose of this decrease is to make sure that our appropriations do not exceed our January 1st cash balance plus actual receipts. The revised appropriation budget for this fund is \$2,233 and the revised appropriation budget for all funds is \$10,095,840.48.

SECTION 2.


That Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; such an emergency arising out of the need to account for the CARES Act Grant monies correctly. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by Council and approved by the Mayor.
