



# ORDINANCE 2020-032

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS IN THE 2020 ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, since the adoption of the Annual Appropriations for the year 2020, certain expenditures have differed from the anticipated expenditures.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.**

That the following adjustment be made in the Annual Appropriations Ordinance 2019-029:

That within the **Fire Engine/Equipment Fund**, appropriations be increased in the amount of **\$20,000** in appropriation account code 2903-120-590-0000 – Other- Capital Outlay. The purpose of this increase is for the purchase of a Tanker and a Ladder Truck for the Fire Department. The revised appropriation budget for this fund is \$82,430 and the revised appropriation budget for all funds is \$10,115,840.48.

**SECTION 2.**

That Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; such an emergency arising out of the need to purchase vehicles for the Fire Department. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by Council and approved by the Mayor.
