



ORDINANCE 2021-017

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS IN THE 2021 ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Annual Appropriations for the year 2021, certain expenditures have differed from the anticipated expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1.

That the following adjustment be made in the Annual Appropriations Ordinance 2020-029:

That within the **Coronavirus Relief Fund**, appropriations be increased in the amount of **\$305.55** in appropriation account code 2151-790-640-0000 - Payment to Another Political Subdivision. The purpose of this increase is to return the unused portion of the Coronavirus (CARES Act) monies to the Shelby County Auditor. The revised appropriation budget for this fund is \$305.55 and the revised appropriation budget for all funds is **\$10,045,318.23**.

That within the **General Fund**, appropriations be transferred in the amount of **\$2,879.58** from appropriation account code 1000-930-930-0000 - Contingencies to appropriation account code 1000-850-720-0000 - Interest. The purpose of this transfer is to provide appropriations for the interest payment that is due on the Peoples Federal Savings & Loan account number 03-41300253 for the real estate that was purchased from METZCOM.

That within the **Electric Operating Fund**, appropriations be transferred in the amount of **\$14,889.00** from appropriation account code 5301-850-710-0000 - Principal to appropriation account code 5301-519-390-0560 - Other Contractual Services (Land & Buildings). The purpose of this transfer is to provide appropriations for the cost of issuance fees for the substation bond issue.

SECTION 2.

That Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; such an emergency arising out of the need to refund the CARES Act monies by the deadline and to provide appropriations to pay expenditures from the proper accounts. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by Council and approved by the Mayor.
