



RESOLUTION 2021-002

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH FREYTAG AND ASSOCIATES INC. FOR PLAN DESIGN FOR ADDITION ONTO EXISTING VILLAGE UTILITIES GARAGE FACILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Jackson Center seeks assistance with design, plans, and submittals for an addition onto Village Utilities Garage; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Jackson Center is constructing a 4320 square foot building addition onto the existing Village Utilities garage located on 108 East Collage St; and

WHEREAS, Freytag and Associates desires to provide these services in exchange for the compensation as set out below; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1.

The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Freytag and Associates Inc. for professional services including but limited to design, plans, submittals;

SECTION 2.

The costs for said services will not exceed Twenty Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$25,800.00).

SECTION 3.

That Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; such an emergency arising out of the need to provide professional services for design, plans and submittals, for the Village Utilities Garage Addition Project. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
