



RESOLUTION 2021-013

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR FUNDING FOR THE WATER PLANT RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT IN THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Public Works Commission, administers financial assistance for local communities for improvement of their basic infrastructure system; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Jackson Center current Water Treatment Plant (WTP) has fifty (50) years of serving the businesses and the residents of the Village. The WTP and its components are reaching the end of their useful life, and

WHEREAS, the Village is planning on construction of a new (WTP) to serve the growth of the Village and the ever-changing rules and regulations of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for the production of high-quality drinking water for consumers, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Jackson Center desires financial assistance under the State of Ohio Public Works Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, SHELBY COUNTY, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1.

That the Village of Jackson Center approves filing an application for the State of Ohio Public Works Commission.

SECTION 2.

That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute contracts with the Public Works Commission and file an application with Ohio Public Works Commission and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION 3.

That the Village of Jackson Center does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project under the terms and conditions of the State of Ohio Public Works Commission.

SECTION 4.

That Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; such an emergency arising out of the need to timely apply for monies for the Water Plant Reconstruction Project. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
