

RULES OF THE POOL



1. All persons entering the pool must purchase a valid ticket or season pass.
2. Season passes and daily admissions are not transferable.
3. Running, chicken fights, dunking, towel snapping, horseplay, pushing, wrestling, throwing of litter, or any other activity deemed dangerous or inappropriate by the lifeguards or management will not be tolerated.
4. No riding or standing on shoulders.
5. No clothes or towels in the pool.
6. No talking to guards while on duty.
7. No one allowed on guard chairs except life guards.
8. No hanging on ropes, or diving from ladders.
9. No balloons in the pool area.
10. Alcoholic beverages and glass containers are not permitted.
11. No smoking on village grounds.
12. ALL Children 10 and under must be accompanied by a responsible person who remains in attendance. The responsible person must remain in close proximity to the children. Parents will be requested to pick up unaccompanied children.
13. No flippers or snorkels, and no hard balls or sharp edges on swimming accessories.
14. Changing rooms and showers are provided.
15. No profane language or gestures permitted.
16. The pool shall be cleared every 45 minutes on the hour for a fifteen (15) minute period, during which time, adult ticket holders may re-enter the water with no more than one (1) preschool child so long as they remain attentive to that child.
17. There will be no loitering inside the bath house or outside the pool area.
18. Infant/Toddlers must wear swim diapers or plastic pants with elastic around the waist and at each leg. No disposable diapers.
19. For safety's sake it is essential that the discipline be maintained, and pool directors are authorized to revoke pool privileges to anyone violating the rule and order of the pool.
20. Food and Drinks permitted, no glass and all coolers subject to inspection.
21. Balls, Frisbees, etc. Should be used some distance from the pool and the bath house.

22. No one is permitted to climb on the roof of the building.
23. Jackson Center Pool is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
24. Appropriate swimming attire is required. No cut-off jeans.
25. Pets are not allowed in the pool area, unless the animal is a guide dog as permitted by law.
26. Persons having open sores, communicable diseases, wounds, severe sunburns, or bandages will be prohibited from the pool area.
27. Absolutely NO DIVING

Deep Water Test: To demonstrate adequate swimming ability in the 5-foot or to use the slide, children must pass a swimming test, even if accompanied by an adult. (width of the pool, tread water for 2 minutes – test done at lifeguards' convenience).

SLIDE RULES

1. Must be 52” tall or pass a swimming proficiency test administered by the lifeguards.
2. For slide users going into water deeper than the height of the user, the user must be able to swim.
3. Only one person on the slide at a time...the next person must remain on the ground until they are off the slide.
4. **NO** head first slides. **NO** standing on the slide.
5. The slide is for single users only with feet first & back only! No chain of people whereby you're holding onto one another, or holding small children when sliding.
6. Body position: Sit down facing the slide slope and hold legs together, users can lay flat.
7. A lifeguard is required to be present at the pool during slide operation.
8. Due to health risks, use of the water slide is not recommended for pregnant women.
9. No lingering in the slide area after sliding down the slide, swim immediately to closest ladder.
10. No life jackets, flotation devices or loose clothing to be worn while sliding.
11. No throwing balls to people sliding off the slide.

THE MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO STOP ANY ACTIVITY THEY FEEL IS HAZARDOUS OR DANGEROUS

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES WILL RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING DISCIPLINARY PLAN:

1st OFFENSE - VERBAL WARNING

2ND OFFENSE—TRASH PICK UP OR SITTING ON THE A BENCH

3rd OFFENSE -SUSPENSION, EXPULSION

FIGHTING & STEALING IS GROUNDS FOR EXPULSION FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE POOL SEASON AND THE POLICE BEING CALLED.
